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Ah, yes, please continue. I am in the presence of the Creator. Yes.

I am in the presence of the Creator. In the presence of the Creator. And I am here.

I am here to invite you to the presence of the Creator. Aha! These people were speaking of mighty works of God, but they were not knowing the language of God. But the natives were outside, but they were all speaking mighty works of God.

So it was a native language, very clearly had. Praise the Lord Jesus. So speaking in tongues of native language, the Lord can use it to speak to people in their language, yet we don't know it.

What is the purpose then? To preach to them that they might understand the works of God that He is doing. Praise the Lord Jesus. Let's go to 1 Corinthians 13.

Amen. Paul was addressing an issue. The issue was loud.

That's when we come to know that it's even tongues of angels. But even when you speak in tongues of angels, what brings us together is loud. And when you miss it, you are wasting time.

They are tongues of angels. The Bible says somewhere, don't you know that angels are the spirits that serve us? We ask a question. That if we speak in English or in Luganda, there are angels here.

Do angels here in Luganda speak in English? What do you think? Let's discuss. Do you think angels hear English or Luganda? They hear English. Why is there a tongue of angels? Since it's for their communication.

And we as people, it's given to us to speak in tongues of angels. That is why Paul says, even when I speak in tongues of angels, that means we can speak a native language and we can speak tongues of angels as well. But most importantly, we all need to be done in love.

Praise the Lord Jesus. As born again. We ask a question.

What do we gain? What do we benefit from speaking in tongues of angels? Because you are speaking, you don't understand what you are speaking. Let me ask you a question. Have you heard of situations where things happen when we didn't ask for them? There is a song that says, some things are done to us before we pray.

I've never read about this. Never read it anywhere. I hear it from the song.

Those things that Jesus does for us before we ask for them. What does he base on to do those things for us? Remember angels are those spirits that serve us. Today we ended the Old Testament.

Those who are on our Bible reading plan. Tomorrow we are resuming the New Testament this year. So you ask yourself, what is that now? You as a born again, there are four things that you need to be doing.

Firstly, you have to hear God through prayer. You learn God through prayer every day. At times you just command God to do whatever you want.

Like how pastor tells us to tell our babies and record the show. You come and perform. Bless them.

One told us that we carry Jesus as a baby at our back. Then we say, Jesus, we are here, send us. But Jesus has to be ahead of you.

When we are praying, we have to ask God what he wants us to do. What is his will? In this situation, what is his will? If he just wants you to do his will, you cannot take days and weeks away. Because you have to do his will.

Because the things are best in his will. Secondly, we have to inquire of him through the Bible. Every day.

The first four things are four. Every day you have to pray. And you have to read your Bible every day.

The scriptures are five. The chapters are five, sometimes four. You find that some are long and deep.

You take four. But after reading, then you go through the Torah. The Torah is one scripture that stands out and speaks to you directly.

Then you note it down. You note it down. And you ask yourself.

Lord, this you are telling me. How should I apply it in my life? Then you pray. He will give you the way he wants you to pass it on.

So that's how we read the Bible. In a year, we go through the Old Testament once. In the New Testament, we go through it two times.

So we finish the New Testament. We are beginning Matthew the first chapter. Praise the Lord Jesus.

So when you look critically in the book of Revelation. Those are the books that I don't read normally. But this time around, Revelation was interesting to me.

Let me tell you why it got very interesting. I imagine John being afraid. Being afraid on that iron thing.

Things I think threaten him. Just read Revelation. You even know that.

When you look critically on things that are spoken of in Revelation. Seeing them happening these days. Seeing them in reality.

Praise the Lord Jesus. But we are not in Revelation. We are on tongues.

There are tongues of angels where you won't understand what you are reading. But the angels understand. Why do you speak what you don't understand? It is the spirit that gives you utterances.

It is not you. Not me. A person who speaks in tongues.

Does not speak because he wants to. He speaks in tongues because he is given utterances. Even if it comes to the tongues of men.

That person does not know. It is the spirit of God that gives you utterances. For a particular purpose.

To speak to a particular group of people. Such that God can transfer what he wants to transfer to these people. If the spirit gives you utterances.

To speak in tongues. And you suppress it. That is disobedience.

Amen. Amen. Now there are things in your life.

Why would you speak in the tongues of angels? Do you know that there are certain elements in our life that we don't want to pray about? Like a gospel cannot pray or even talk gospel. Because it destroys the church. It sort of disorganizes us.

To make some of them stumble away. Then when you are speaking in the tongues of angels. Just praying.

The spirit will give you utterances. To speak to the angels. To not perform that situation in your life.

And even you in your own ability that you can't pray against. You will find that you pray against those circumstances in your life. And your life will start to change.

Then you start to ask yourself, how did it start? How to pray for this thing? How come they are changing? Praise God. It's important to speak in tongues. But the tongues of angels don't need interpretation.

It does not need to be interpreted. Because you are not speaking to men. You are

speaking to angels.

To minister to your situation. Hallelujah. 1 Corinthians 14.26 Let us look also at another facet.

Another kind of tongues. 1 Corinthians 14.26 Bible. 1 Corinthians 14.26 So here we see that there are even tongues that need to be interpreted.

They are supposed to be interpreted. Because it edifies the body of Christ. Now in the Corinthian church.

Just as it is in the Ugandan church. You will find in a church these days. You will find in a church maybe 5, 6, 7 people speaking in tongues at the same time.

Yet they are giving edification to the body of Christ. It is not them speaking the tongues of angels. Not to angels but to fellow believers.

God says in such circumstances. Let there be at least two. A maximum of three.

But in that midst there must be an interpreter. There must be someone who is going to interpret what the Lord is passing through these people. Imagine if we are to sing a song.

Mama Rose starts to sing. And Michael starts to sing. I am a friend of God.

And someone from the back is singing another song. What will be in the church? What do you think will happen? Chaos. Chaos.

In the same way. If brother Solomon starts to prophesy. Sister Prossy prophesies.

All at the same time. What happens? Chaos. Now.

How come if it comes to the speakers of tongues. Those who speak in tongues. Everyone wants to start speaking in tongues randomly.

Yet edifying the body of Christ. Yet edifying the body of Christ. Sending a message that edifies the body of Christ.

How would it be if I started preaching in tongues. And she started interpreting in tongues. Yet we are supposed to pass a message.

Praise God. So there are tongues that need to be interpreted. Now where there is no interpreter of such.

Apostle Paul says. Hold your peace. Hold your tongues.

As long as it is for the edification of the body of Christ. Now those are three types of

tongues. There are also written tongues.

You remember in Daniel. You remember in Daniel. The written tongue needed an interpreter.

Let us go to the book of Daniel. Daniel 5.24 Now as the body of Christ. We need to know where to use what and when.

And we need to use it well. We need to use it well. 524 524 So, this king.

So, this king. So, this king. The half hand.

Whenever the hand of the Lord comes up to his right, when he comes up to write, God does not want to write on stones for his servant's heart. The Lord wants to write in your heart that his word may come to you directly, but whenever your heart is covered, refusing to give God access, his hand comes out and inscribes, and whenever the hand writes, those are kings coming in. Now, there is a talent that writes.

It writes down a message to someone, but that message also needs interpretation. Praise God. It needs interpretation.

That's another kind of talent. The way God transfers his information to people. The written.

God will always write. God can do anything that he wants to be done, if the message was to have to pass through. I was impressed this morning about our sister and her child, about the snoring of the child.

Now, immediately she said the child was over snoring too much. In my mind, I said, okay, so what's wrong with that? But because she didn't like the idea that she did it, maybe the snoring was about the good life. She passed out.

Every Christian has to have 10 senses. A lamb has to have 6 senses. If someone touches you, you feel that someone has touched you.

If someone is speaking, you hear that someone has. If someone passes, you know. If someone is bad, you know that something is smelly.

When you put food in your tongue, you can taste. You can taste it. There are 10 senses.

So a Panagian has to have those 10 senses. You have to be seeing physically and spiritually seeing. You have to be hearing physically and in the spirit you do.

You have to be tasting and even in the spirit you taste. You have to be smelling physically and in your spirit you have to taste. If that day comes, I will bring out those pictures.

What do you see? Hard. There are things that the born again does not do. It is very hard for a born again to raise up their hand in church and say, praise the Lord Jesus.

1 Corinthians 14.2 1 Corinthians 14.2 This is one of those things that I say is very important. Very important. There are two that are very important to me.

The tongue of angels. I am on my things and the angels are fixing my issues. So you were sleeping, you prayed, those people passed by, the angels are working and some people are planning to harm you.

You won't be able to pray because you don't know them. But when you are praying in tongues of angels, because it is the spirit that gives you utterance, the Lord knows your issues. He sends the angels to work upon you in your unknowing.

1 Corinthians 14.4 1 Corinthians 14.4 So when the Lord gives you the gift of speaking in tongues, and you get an opportunity of preaching, my friend, don't speak in tongues. Because one who speaks in tongues does not speak to people. It is not that for the book of Acts.

Paul here has told us that the one who speaks in tongues speaks to God. What he is speaking is the word of God. There is even a saying that goes on that you have not even reached that scripture.

That when you are speaking in tongues, even the devil can't hear what you are saying. Maybe it is true. If what you are speaking is hard, people don't hear you.

I think even angels don't hear this one. It is the one they hear. My question is how do you distinguish? Because it is not you speaking, it is God making you utter.

Why? Because we don't know how we should pray. Do you know what you are supposed to pray for today? You pray for what you need or what you have understood. But there are things that you are not yet.

And God is like, I wish this my child can pray for this thing. You remember a prophet who told...

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
